

MINUTES OF MEETING Budget Committee May 2, 2022 7:00 PM

I. COMMUNICATIONS

Minutes of a meeting of the Budget Committee of the Chemung County Legislature held in the Hazlett Building, 5th Floor, 203 Lake Street, Elmira, New York on Monday, May 2, 2022.

Members and officials present: John Pastrick, David Manchester, L. Thomas Sweet, Joseph Brennan, Mark Margeson, Brian Hyland, Christina Sonsire, Peggy Woodard, John Burin, Martin Chalk, Robert Briggs, William McCarthy, Scott Drake, Michael Smith, Rodney Strange, Bryan Maggs, Matt Fogarty

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman of the committee, David Manchester.

1. Summary of Fund Financial Results, 2021

Mr. Burin asked if the 2021 \$7.7 million surplus for payroll was typical or if it was exceptional due to COVID. He asked if there is a plan to address ongoing personnel shortages (vacancies).

II. RESOLUTIONS, MOTIONS, AND NOTICES

1. Resolution authorizing transfers and appropriations by the County Executive

Motion made by Martin Chalk, seconded by John Burin, and Passed with a vote of 7-0, authorizing transfers and appropriations by the County Executive.

2. Resolution amending Capital Program as contained in the 2022 Chemung County Budget (snow removal equipment)

Motion made by John Burin, seconded by Joseph Brennan, and Passed with a vote of 7-0, amending Capital Program as contained in the 2022 Chemung County Budget (snow removal equipment).

3. Resolution authorizing certain applications for and disbursement of Community Development Funds (Legislature)

Mrs. Sonsire requested that the Budget Committee consider amending this resolution to include a contribution of \$1,000 from the 7th District for the Moving Vietnam Wall.

Mr. Sweet stated that the Zimmerman House, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, has a stain glass window that is in need of repair. He asked if Community Development funds could be used for this project. Attorney Maggs stated that not for profit organizations are only able to receive funds directly when the purpose for which the funds will meet the statutory

requirements. Attorney Maggs will research if this project meets these requirements. Mr. Chalk thanked legislators for contributing some of their Community Development funds toward the Vietnam Moving Wall.

Motion made by Mr. Chalk, seconded by Mr. Burin to amend resolution authorizing certain applications for and disbursement of Community Development Funds (Legislature) to include \$1,000 from the 7th District for the Moving Vietnam Wall. The motion carried by a vote of 7-0.

III. OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Burin stated that in April of 2020, New York State was projecting a four-year deficit of \$69 million, however, due to the federal government stimulus, as of March 31, 2022, the four- year projection is now a surplus of \$40 billion. Chemung County ("the County") has a \$14.7 million surplus, \$8.7 million more than what was projected for 2021. The County received \$8.1 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds in June of 2021, and \$7 million of those funds remain unspent. Mr. Burin noted that the County will receive another \$8.1 in ARPA funds in 2022. He stated that while he understands why the County Executive is holding off on providing the Orange Zone and Agricultural Subsidy programs, he doesn't agree. He feels that the County has a great opportunity to providing ARPA funds for what believes is the number one concern to the taxpayers, public safety. Mr. Burin suggested that these funds could be used for targeted patrol and advanced law enforcement technology resources that would enhance our communities safety, but unfortunately lack the funds to do so. He suggested bringing together countywide law enforcement experts, and asking them to come up with a plan to submit to the County Executive. Mr. Manchester stated that he does not understand why the County Executive is not proceeding with the Orange Zone and Agricultural Subsidy programs, noting that there are numerous businesses and farms that could benefit from the Programs. He also stated that there is a process in place to to help these businesses/organizations that have gone through unprecedented times, and have suffered financially. These funds were designed to be put back into the community. Mrs. Sonsire stated that she likes the idea of using ARPA funds to enhance public safety. Mr. Sweet stated that while attending a meeting of the Landbank he learned that the number one concern for the Director of LECOM is the safety of students. Mr. Drake likes the idea of investing in ways to enhance public safety and stated that the Legislature should have minimal involvement in the developing such a plan.

Mr. Strange informed the Legislature that the new Director of Cornell Cooperative Extension (CCE) of Chemung County, Michelle Podolec will be providing a presentation to the Legislature at the Standing Committees meeting on Monday, June 27, 2022. He noted that any questions for the Director should be sent to the Clerk prior to the presentation. Mr. Smith stated that he is happy to hear CCE will be providing a presentation to the Legislature to understand the nature of the many programs CCE provides to our community.

Mr. Margeson stated that a number of neighboring counties have passed resolutions to temporarily decrease sales tax on gasoline. He suggested that this may be something that that Chemung County should consider as a way to relieve some of the burden on the taxpayers in the community during these times of inflation.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Briggs requested that the Chairman of the Legislature extend an invitation to the County Executive to attend the May 23, 2022 Health and Human Services Committee meeting to share his objections to the establishment of a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) in Chemung County. Mr. Manchester will extend the invitation as requested by Mr. Briggs. He noted that multiple invitations have been extended to the County Executive over the past few months to attend specific meetings of the Legislature however he has never received a response.

Mr. Margeson asked if there is any update/action on the District Attorney's (DA's) office space. Mr.

Manchester noted that he has not received any further updates regarding the DA's office space.

V. ADJOURNMENT

This meeting was adjourned on the motion made by Mr. Manchester, seconded by Mr. Chalk. Motion Carried.

The purpose of this communication is to provide a summary of select unaudited fund financial results to the Chemung County Legislature for the year ended 12-31-21. Those results are attached and represent unaudited account balances for 2021 as of 4-25-22.

This summary schedule includes all of the County's Governmental Funds, Proprietary Enterprise Funds, and Internal Service Funds, as well as the Fiduciary Custodial Fund. The government wide information is not presented here, and neither are the results of the County's component units. The purpose of this report is for Legislative communication only.

These numbers are unaudited and subject to additional adjustments as my staff and I, along with other fiscal staff throughout the county, proceed through the audit process. Over the course of the next several weeks and into June 2022, independent auditors will conduct an audit of the 2021 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (including the County's 2021 financial statements), as well as the several other required audits of the Chemung County Nursing Facility; Federal Single Audit (Uniform Guidance); NYS DOT Audit; Airport Passenger Facility Charges Audit; and audit of the County's Deferred Compensation Plan.

Once finalized, all audit reports will be made available to the Legislature, the County Executive's Office, and to the all other stakeholders, including the public.

Tricia: We have reviewed the bids for the Airport snow removal equipment (SRE). The Airport will prepare a route slip with the recommendation to award.

MB is low bid, however they fail to meet specifications on:

- item 5.15.3 regarding slope of the windshield- This was an exemption that the Airport denied. We have experience with this design. The design inhibits visibility and is in our opinion a safety hazard.
- item 5.15.8 regarding the exterior visor- This was an exemption that the Airport denied.
- Item 4,c regarding slope of windshield- This was an exemption that the Airport denied. We have experience with this design. The design inhibits visibility and is in our opinion a safety hazard.
- Item 12.1 regarding local support within 150 miles. This was an exemption that the Airport denied. The Airport
 has extensive experience with the factory support proposed by MB. It is the Airport's experience that MB factory
 support is inadequate. It can take several days to arrange support. This is particularly a concern in winter
 weather conditions when equipment breaks down and the company has nationwide support requests.

MB had requested changes to the bid to include the above exemptions. We allowed the majority of requested changes however did not accept the above because of the importance of these specifications.

The next lowest bid was Oshkosh. Oshkosh met the bid requirements without any exemptions.

I am making the recommendation that the contract be awarded to Oshkosh. Please advise if you need any additional information or documentation.
